NO FREQUENT JOB CHANGES

Avoid switching jobs just for the CTC. First, explore your abilities well in the current role, have a deep understanding of how you can utilize your skills.



DIVERSIFY EARLY IN SKILL SETS

Try to be inclusive and interact with cross-functions, to have diversified knowledge that can letter be translated into a skill you may wish to explore



FEEDBACK IS THE MANTRA TO SUCCESS

Seek feedback from everyone you can ask, it will help you to overcome your shortcomings. Remember <u>feedback is always</u> sought, not given.

SOME MORE POINTS TO REMEMBER

- Learning: learn from available resources and from others
- Be Helpful: by helping others you can sharpen your skills and at the same time have a good community
- Active Participation: always participate in discussions, activities, and events. It gives you visibility early in your career
- Boss is not always correct: voice your opinion whenever necessary
